SUBJECT: AVAILABILITY OF PROPERTY

There are two purposes for this letter. First, the letter provides a clarification on the CMSP policy regarding the availability of property. Second, the letter provides notification of the elimination of the CMSP 204 form.

Policy on the Availability of Property. Property that is not accessible to the client due to verified legal constraints or a lack of competence, verified by a physician statement, shall not be considered in determining eligibility for the whole certification period. Follow-up regarding such property shall be completed at the time of reapplication. Counties are instructed to follow this policy effective immediately. CMSP Eligibility Manual Sections 7-012 and 7-054 will be revised to reflect this change and shall be included in the quarterly CMSP Eligibility Manual revision dated September 30, 2007.

CMSP 204 Form. The CMSP 204 form is no longer in use and has been eliminated effective October 1, 2007.
